As you share your piece, please let us know:

- 1. What is your connection to this form of needlework or embroidery?
- 2. Where does this tradition originate?
- 3. What was your experience in stitching it?

If you would like to receive a certificate of completion for the professional development series, we will ask you to complete this "manageably sized" capstone project before December 12th. Capstone projects will be shared during our monthly Saturday Zoom meetings. You may choose to present your findings either October 17th, November 14th, or December 12th.
